CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING CORNER: THOUGHTS ON

FAITHFUL CITIZENSHIP- First Principle of Catholic Social Teaching: The Life and Dignity of the Human Person ~ Scripture expounds that we are made in the image and likeness of God – God who is love. The church in the modern world, states Vatican II, is to be a sign of the dignity of the human person. Human life is sacred. We believe that every person is precious, that people are more important than things, and that the measure of every institution is whether it threatens or enhances the life and dignity of the human person. The Catholic community is called to shape public policy that protects and defends human life and human dignity from the moment of conception until the moment of natural death. This would include legislation relating to abortion, embryonic stem cell research, cloning, infanticide, physician assisted suicide, and the death penalty. It would also include legislation relating to all that is needed to support life, meaning adequate food, shelter, health care, education and work; as well as condemning any assault on human dignity such as hate crimes, pre-emptive war, racism and torture.
