**CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING CORNER:
THOUGHTS ON FAITHFUL CITIZENSHIP- Week 4:
(Feb. 5):**

The Third Principle of Catholic Social Teaching: Rights and Responsibilities ~ As created images of God, people have basic rights and responsibilities. Every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities - to one another, to our family, and to the larger society.

Our rights flow from our human dignity and call us to public policy that defends those things required for human life, food, shelter, health care, education, and employment. It also calls everyone to be responsible: to work honestly, to care for one's health to seek adequate education, to provide sufficient food and shelter, etc. As Catholics, we are called to participate in the political process by voting and helping to shape the laws that govern our society.
