

Men's Ministry Minutes  
June 27, 2006

Election were completed: Officers elected were: Leo DeLaGarza as President; Albert Banda as Vice-President; and Zach Patterson as Secretary. Members at large: Alfred Calvo and Ray Saldana.

Ralph Briceno proposed that the Men's Ministry provide parking support for St. Anthony's in Kyle, Texas on September 15, 16, and 17. We would earn one half of the proceeds (parking fees) or an estimated amount of \$2,000. The festival would be a three day event from the hours of 5 pm to 11 pm. The proposal was discussed and approved by all members present. We will need to provide 15 men per day. Ralph will be the coordinating this event. More later.

GuadalupeFest was discussed and recommendations made. Most people enjoyed the event even though it rained. We are still calculating the total amount of revenues. It is estimated to be \$1,600 to \$2,000 after expenses are deducted. The members proposed planning for a Christmas and Spring Festival. Marcelino proposed contributing dollars to the food pantry at OLG. Motion was not seconded and it was decided to review his proposal at our next meeting after budget is finalized.

Tina Rodriguez a member of the parish had requested the Men's Ministry provide community support and supervision to her two sons.
