## **Religious Education Attendance Policy**

Our Lady of Guadalupe Church

To participate in the First Communion Class for grade 2 a student must attend one full year of Religious Education Classes. This year must be immediately prior to entering the First Communion Class. One full year means that a student must attend at least eighty percent (80%) of classes during the school year.

For high school students to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation a student must attend two full years of Religious Education Classes. One full year means that a student must attend at least eighty percent (80%) of classes during the school year.

For all other classes with attendance requirements, one full year means that a student must attend at least eighty percent (80%) of classes during the school year.

## **Drop off and Pick up Policy**

**Parents must bring their student to the classroom and sign them in to the class. At the end of class, parents must pick up their student from the classroom and sign them out of class.**

Students will not be admitted to class without a parent, nor will they be allowed to leave the classroom alone. This is for the safety of all of our children. **This includes students in the Junior High and High School students.** Failure to do so could lead to your child not being allowed to participate in the Religious Education program.

This policy has been recommended to us by the Diocese of Austin.

## **Religious Education Behavior Policy**

Our Lady of Guadalupe Church

### **Before Class Begins**

- Parents must take all students to the classrooms and sign them in with the catechist.\*
- Students are not allowed to leave the classroom once dropped off by their parents.\*

### **During Class**

- Everyone is to be treated with courtesy and respect. This includes students, catechists, parents, parish staff and parish volunteers.
- Students will come to class prepared to learn and willing to participate in class activities.
- Students will not be allowed to interfere with the learning and participation of other students.
- Students will not bully or intimidate other students, either through their words or actions.
- Students will respect the classroom and materials.
- Students will respect the belongings of others.
- Cell phones, pagers and mp3 players may not be used. Texting during class is not allowed. Catechists and members of the parish staff may take any electronic device that is being used during class time.

### **After Class**

- Parents must come to the classroom to pick up their children and sign them out.\*
- Students may not leave the parish grounds alone.\*
- Parents must pick up their children promptly after class ends. Catechists are not baby-sitters. Please make arrangements to have your child(ren) picked up from the classroom on time. For Sunday classes, parents may need to leave Mass early to do this.

\* Students 18 years old and older may be excused from this rule if their parents bring a signed note to the parish office.

### **Student behavior problems will result in the following actions (in this order)**

1. A student will be told that her or his behavior is disrupting class and asked to change the behavior.
2. The catechists will discuss the behavior with the parents and ask them to speak with their child about making positive behavior choices.
3. The Director of Religious Education will call the parents and ask them to speak with their child about making positive behavior choices.
4. Parents will be required to attend class with their child in order for them to continue in our Religious Education program.
