Youth Sacrament Class Requirements

Grades 6 – 12

2007-08 School Year

To enroll in the Youth Sacrament Class at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, all youth must meet the following requirements.

- For **Baptism**, parents must turn in a copy of the youth's Birth Certificate at the time of registration.
- For **First Communion**, parents must turn in a copy of the youth's Baptism certificate at the time of registration.
- For **Confirmation**, parents must turn in a copy of the youth's Baptism and First Communion certificates at the time of registration. Only students who enter this program in 11th grade will be able to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation after two years. All other students will attend the high school Confirmation class following this two year program.
- Tuition (\$40) must be paid at the time of registration. All youth who meet the requirements are welcome to participate in the class even if their family is unable to pay the tuition. Do not hesitate to call the office for more information.
- Sponsors of those receiving the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation who are married must have their marriage blessed by the Catholic Church. They must also be fully initiated Catholics who have been Baptized and Confirmed and who have received their First Communion. Copies of the Sponsor's Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation certificates must be turned in at the time of registration.
- If the sponsors of those receiving the Sacraments of Baptism or Confirmation are not registered parishioners of Our Lady of Guadalupe, they must bring a "Letter of Good Standing" from their church saying that they are registered, active members at the time of registration.

To be eligible to celebrate the sacraments at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, a family must fulfill the following obligations.

1. Students and parents (or other adults) must attend at least **80%** of classes each year.
2. Youth and parents (or other adults) must attend all retreats and rehearsals.

After the above requirements are met, the youth can celebrate the sacraments for which they have prepared. If you have questions, please contact the parish office.
